CLASS A - RING EVENTS - Regulations

- 1. ALL COMPETITION at this show is governed by these regulations and by the Ag-Shows NSW Rules for Discipline in Horse Sections at Shows which can be viewed at the Marshalling van, Secretary's Office and on www.agshowsnsw.org.au Should it become necessary for the ASC Disciplinary Committee to open an inquiry into any aspect of competition in this Horse Section, this Society will support any penalty imposed by that Committee as a result of the inquiry and will support penalties resulting from enquiries arising from Horse Sections at other NSW shows.
- 2. The Rules & Regulations of Condobolin PAH & I Association Inc, as in full Show Schedule, also apply.
- 3. INDEMNITY AND WAIVER FORMS. The Horse Committee will take all care in managing the Section, but competitors taking part in this Horse Section do so at their own risk. Each adult competitor must, before competing, complete and sign a form indemnifying the Condobolin PAH&I Association Inc and waiving any claims against the association for any injury sustained in competition or for loss or damage to the competitor's property or damage caused by the competitor or his/her animal(s) at the Show. A similar form must also be completed and signed by a parent or guardian (ONLY) for each competitor who is under 18 years of age. Completed and signed form to be submitted at marshalling van on arrival. Additional forms available at van. Waiver must also be completed by ALL handlers and persons entering the Ring or handling horses on the showground. Wristbands (provided when Indemnity and Waiver Forms presented) MUST be worn while on Condobolin Showground.
- 4. HORSE HEALTH DECLARATION. All competitors must complete a Horse Health Declaration; each horse which the competitor has brought onto the Showground must be listed together with the Property Identification Code (PIC) of the property from which the horse came to the Show.
- 5. DRUGS. The Condobolin PAH & I Association Inc has a zero tolerance of performance enhancing drugs. Drug testing may be carried out at this Show. Any competitor, owner, attendant of any horse, found to have breached the AgShows NSW Disputes and Disciplinary Regulation will be investigated by the AgShows NSW Disciplinary Committee.
- 6. ENTRY Horse/rider combination numbers to be collected from marshalling van.
 - Entry Fees Free Entry Ring 1, Day 1. Otherwise \$3. Entry fees to be paid to steward in ring. Please have coins ready as change will not be given.
 - Rings 4 & 5 (Showjumping) enter through globalentriesonline.com.au
- 7. PRIZE MONEY & RIBBONS As stated at head of each Ring or adjacent to Event.
- 8. **In the case of two classes clashing**, competitor to choose which class to enter and no Ring will be held up for any competitor.
- 9. **Events** to be judged in order shown, commencing at time at head of each Ring.
- Refusal of Entry/Alteration of Schedule The Committee reserves the right to refuse an entry without assigning a reason for so doing and to alter the schedule to meet emerging circumstances.
- 11. Judges Decision/Discretion The judge is empowered to withhold any or all prizes in any class where the exhibits are, in his/her opinion, unworthy of the prize, and always, the judge's decision will be final. A judge has the discretion to ask that a led or performance exhibit and handler/rider be ordered to leave the ring if he/she considers the animal is unruly and/or likely to cause an accident.

12. **NO HORSES** are to be on the Show arena unless being judged. NO HORSES are to be tethered to Show Ring perimeter fence.

13. **FENCES**:

- Electric fences not permitted. Tape fences not permitted.
- Portable yards not permitted in camping area. A limited area of the ground is available, but only by application, at a cost (advise when booking stall)
- Horses MUST be stalled in stalls provided overnight.
- 14. PARKING Exhibitors and competitors must park or camp in designated areas only. There is to be no parking around perimeter of Show ring or ring road or on soccer ground. Day Parking only in Day Camping / Parking area (site of old stables, east of Soccer Ground).
- 15. **Horses to be worked** in one of the TWO DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY: east of marshalling van and as marked at rear of Day Camping area. No working of horses on Soccer Ground.
- 16. STALLIONS ineligible for Hack events. All colts and stallions over the age of 12 months must adhere to the Stallion Safe Practice Act of 1 July 2018. Also they must have a bit in mouth when outside stable and must be under the control of a person 18 years of age or older at all times.
- 17. **MEASURING** No official measuring will take place at the show, but if a question arises about height, proof of height may be required. In the absence of proof a decision will be at the absolute discretion of the Ringmaster or Chief Ring Steward.
- 18. **LEAVING RING** If a led horse should drag or escape its handler or a ridden horse takes control of or unseats its rider and leaves the ring, it is usually disqualified from class.
- 19. Clipped horses allowed.
- HELMETS Riders must wear an approved safety helmet as approved by Equestrian Australia's current standards. Helmet Tagging is mandatory for all EA Affiliated Jumping events.
- 21. PROTEST Any protest must be made in writing to the Show Secretary within an hour after the event or half an hour before the event. A Protest Committee shall deal with all protests and its decision shall be final. The sum of \$100 must be lodged with each protest and this sum may be forfeit if the Committee considers the protest frivolous.
- 22. REGISTRATION PAPERS for all registered horses must be available on demand.
- 23. EXHIBITS IN BREED CLASSES must be registered with the relevant society & exhibitor must be a current financial member, proof of which must be produced if requested.
- 24. NOVICE A horse which has not won a first prize at any Show in a similar class.
- 25. INTERMEDIATE A horse which has not won a first prize at any Royal Show.
- 26. **LOCAL** restricted to horses, owners and riders in Lachlan Shire or within 50 km Condobolin whichever is the furthest, or members of Condobolin Pony Club, and owned by the competitor three months prior to competition.
- 27. AGE OF RIDER, is taken as at first day of Show.
- 28. AGE OF HORSE shall be calculated from 1st August in the year in which it was foaled.
- 29. IMPROPER BEHAVIOUR Outside assistance to competitors by word or any other method will NOT be permitted. If in breach of this ruling, competitors may be dismissed from the event and the ground. Such competitor's names to be forwarded to AgShows NSW.

- 30. ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION not to be used by competitors while competing.
- 31. **APPROACHING JUDGES:** No exhibitor or associate will initiate conversation with a judge on judging day, before, during or after judging except through the Ringmaster or Chief Steward. No competitor will present for judging before a judge with whom he/she has a family relationship, has or recently had a personal relationship or has had horse related business.
- 32. **VETERINARY COSTS** In the case of an exhibit requiring veterinary inspection / treatment, exhibitors agree that all costs incurred are their responsibility.
- 33. CAMPING CHARGES \$15 per day (includes power). Showground has had a major power upgrade and power is available for all sites. Exhibitors are reminded that all leads, tools and appliances must carry a valid test tag and be fixed overhead.
- 34. **STALLS** are covered and some are in shed. All are \$20 per horse. NO STRAW allowed. Sawdust is provided.
- 35. **STALL BOOKING** All bookings to be made on form on page 11 and stalls are only reserved if payment is enclosed when booking or EFT received.
- 36. **DOGS** Assistance and competition dogs only are permitted and all dogs on ground are to be securely tied or on a leash **at all times**.
- 37. **TROPHIES** will be presented at the completion of event.
- 38. **LUNCH BREAK** to be announced to accommodate Official Opening &/or Show ring entertainment
- 39. GRAND PARADE 3.30 p.m. Saturday.
- 40. GROUND ENTRY www.123tix All persons not being members of the association must pay ground entry at all Shows in C.W. Group 10. Entrants in Ring Events on Friday may obtain the Saturday pass from the Marshalling van for free entry on Saturday one per person on completion of day's events.
- 41. SPEED LIMIT Please observe the inground vehicle speed limit of 10 km/h.

DAY CAMPING AREA - Vehicles, Vans etc

Day Parking on ground must use designated DAY CAMPING/PARKING AREA - east of soccer ground

NO PARKING on roadsides or around Show Ring (pre-paid sites) and NO HORSES on Soccer Ground
